## PERSPECTIVE

This is the second of our “canvas wines” and the second vintage of this wine. We have used three varieties stretched across five vineyards, and this wine remains our main focus in terms of red wine. This blend continues to grow in terms of vineyards and varieties as we stretch our reach further across the Swartland. The Red blend has great structure while showing red and black fruit with trademark Swartland fynbos and olive notes. Syrah dominates this blend followed by Tinta Barocca and Cinsault.
