

## Spioenkop Wines

From the very beginning, it was our crucial goal to source the perfect grapes in Elgin that are unique and fit in the style of wine that was already in my head ...

## Spioenkop Pinotage 2018

Grapes 100% Pinotage "Klipkop"/B7 - Elgin

Aspect West face - South face

Altitude 180 m

Soil type shale and clay soils

Rootstock R 101 - 1
Age of the vines 11 years
Trellising bush vine

Harvest date the 12<sup>th</sup> of February 2018

Winemaking record Hand-picked grapes in small 18 kg crates, one night in the cool store  $(8^{\circ}C)$  and

then destemmed. Five days cold soak in our red fermenter, followed by

spontaneous wild yeast fermentation. After fermentation, the grape-skins were slowly pressed in a stainless steel basket press (JLB 5). Natural malolactic fermentation in selected barrels. Barrel ageing, without any racking, for 10

months - no fining and no filtering.

Maturation prior to release 10 months on its natural fine lees (80% new barrels)

Bottling the 23<sup>th</sup> of January 2019

Wine analysis Alcohol 13.68 %

Total acid 6.70 g/l pH 3,31 g/l Residual sugar 2.10 g/l

Cellaring potential 15 years

Winemakers comments The wine shows a healthy dark-ruby/purple colour and the bouquet offers,

at first, intense terroir flavours of graphite, violets, black olives and dark forest fruit. Later you detect cassis, cinnamon and cloves. The palate also offers leather, red cherry, potpourri and dried apricots. This is an elegant style of Pinotage. In addition to this it's a medium bodied wine with a nice dense, pure and wonderful acidity. A nice satin texture finishes this wine which can be drunk over

the next 10 - 15 years.
